## Hearing aids and Bluetooth

Hearing aids have come a long way since digital technology has been introduced. One of the most exciting new developments is that there are now hearing systems that are bluetooth compatible.

Many hearing aid users have problems hearing on the telephone and on their cell phone in particular because these often aren't hearing aid compatible. Now if you have a bluetooth phone and a hearing aid that is bluetooth compatible the bluetooth signal can be sent via a bluetooth receiver directly to the hearing aids. This eliminates feedback problems and allows the hearing aid user to hear on the phone in stereo. Better yet it's hands free. This technology can also be used to listen to an iPod, the television or with any device with a headset jack or bluetooth. The hearing aids become wireless headphones.

## What is Bluetooth ?

Bluetooth® is wireless communication technology. It allows two-way audio or data streaming between Bluetooth devices such as computers, mobile phones and PDAs. Bluetooth devices send data and voice in a clean, clear, digital format up to 10 meters.
